

Lead Safe Work Practices

Many homes built before 1978 contain lead-based paint, so it is important that renovation, remodeling and repair activities (both interior and exterior) use methods that reduce and control dust and debris created during work. Even a small amount of dust can pose a serious health risk to children and families. The goal of this program is to teach attendees lead-safe work practices and the strategies for implementing them.

Topics Covered:

- Module 1-Why Should I Be Concerned about Lead Dust?
- Module 2-Set Up Your Work Space to Contain Lead Dust
- Module 3-Safe Work Practices
- Module 4-Clean Up and Check Your Work
- Module 5-Planning The Job

At the end of the training session, attendees may take a 25 question exam. Those scoring 75% or better may receive a certificate of course completion.
