



INSPECTOR EXCHANGE PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION: The inspector exchange is an organized visit between jurisdictions to showcase successes, discuss problems, and pass along ideas to make code compliance programs work better and to be more consistent.

PURPOSE: To foster communication that will lead to more efficient, effective and improved housing safety. Participants will be exposed to methods and systems that others use, and will be able to evaluate the effectiveness of those methods and systems with a constructive view from the outside. Participants may be able to use ideas from their visit to improve their own operations.

HOW IT WORKS: Communities submit applications to MAHO. The MAHO board will pair up communities based on the information supplied in the application. Participants will arrange the dates, times, and number of persons in the exchange.
